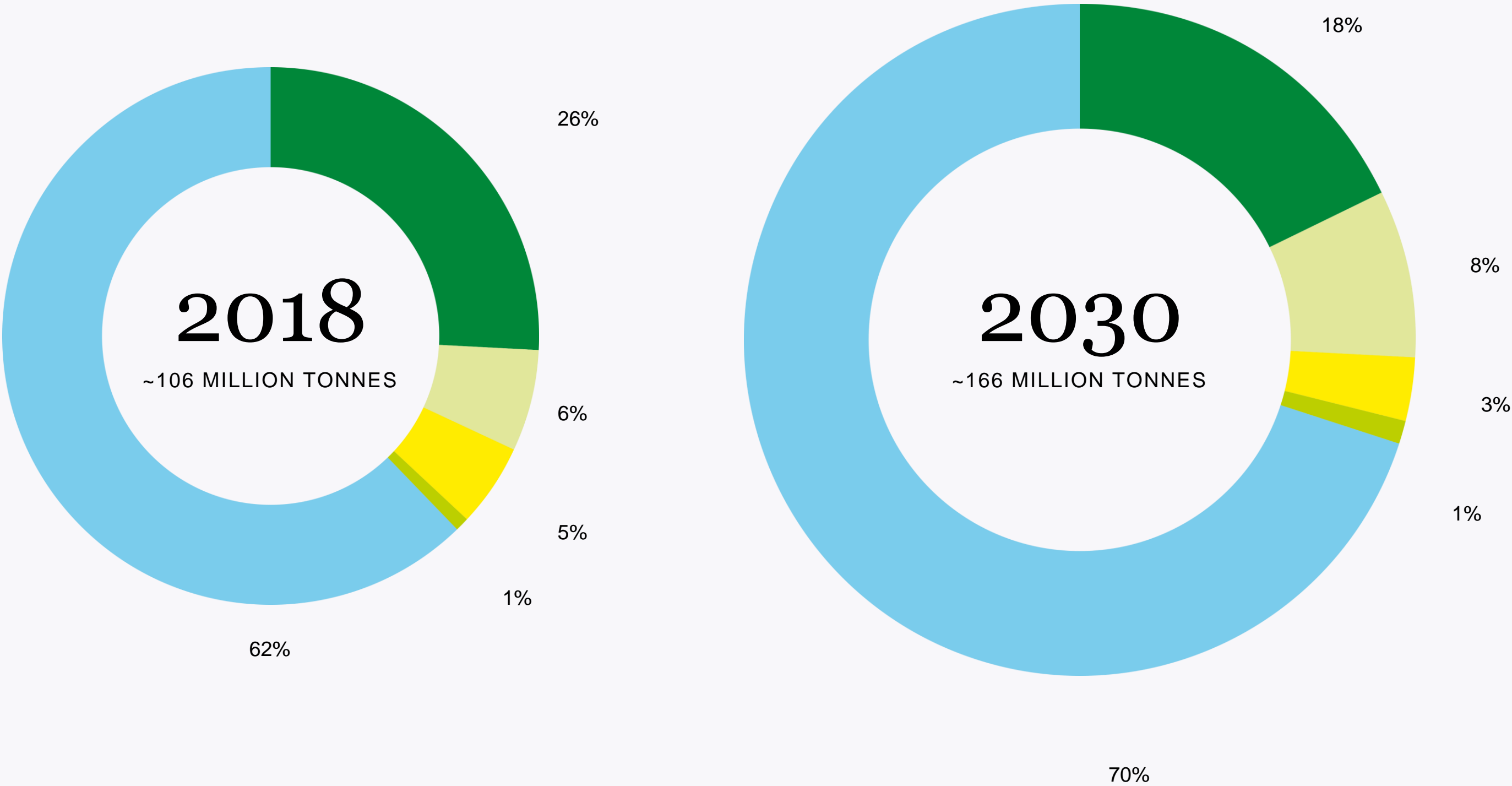

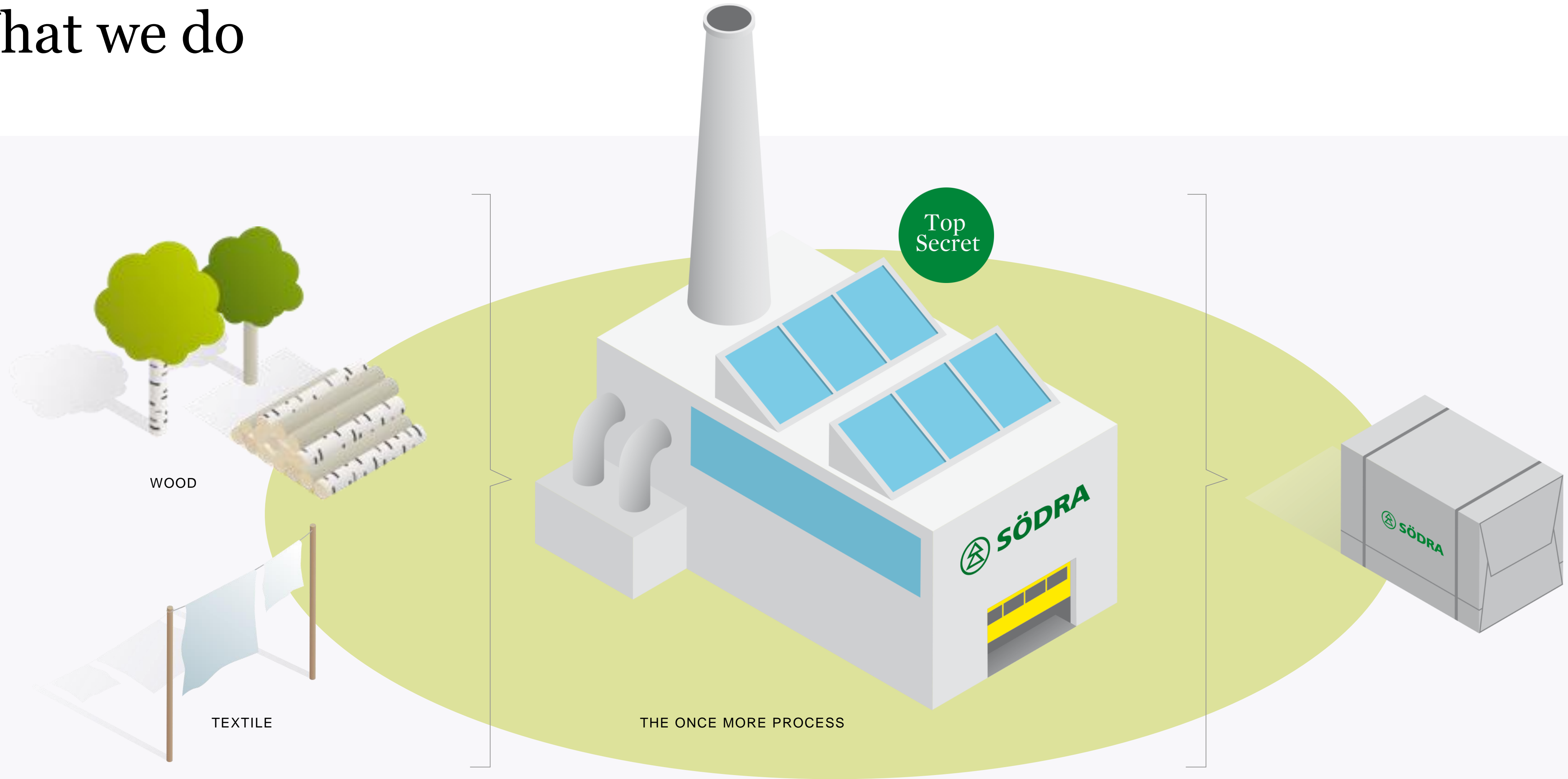

## OnceMore at the moment

- Containing 20% recycled post-consumer waste.
- In June 2022 we will have a capacity of 6000 tonnes of OnceMore-pulp, approx. 24 millions of garments.



# Teaming up with Lenzing

A collaboration to boost post-consumer textile waste recycling

Involves transferring knowledge and joint development

The goal is to process 25,000 tons of textile waste per year by 2025





# Another world first: Recycling coloured textiles

56 000 garments from ICA's workwear

Return logistics for minimum transports

Involvement from the employees,  
collection and trim removal

Will be recycled into 28 000 viscose garments





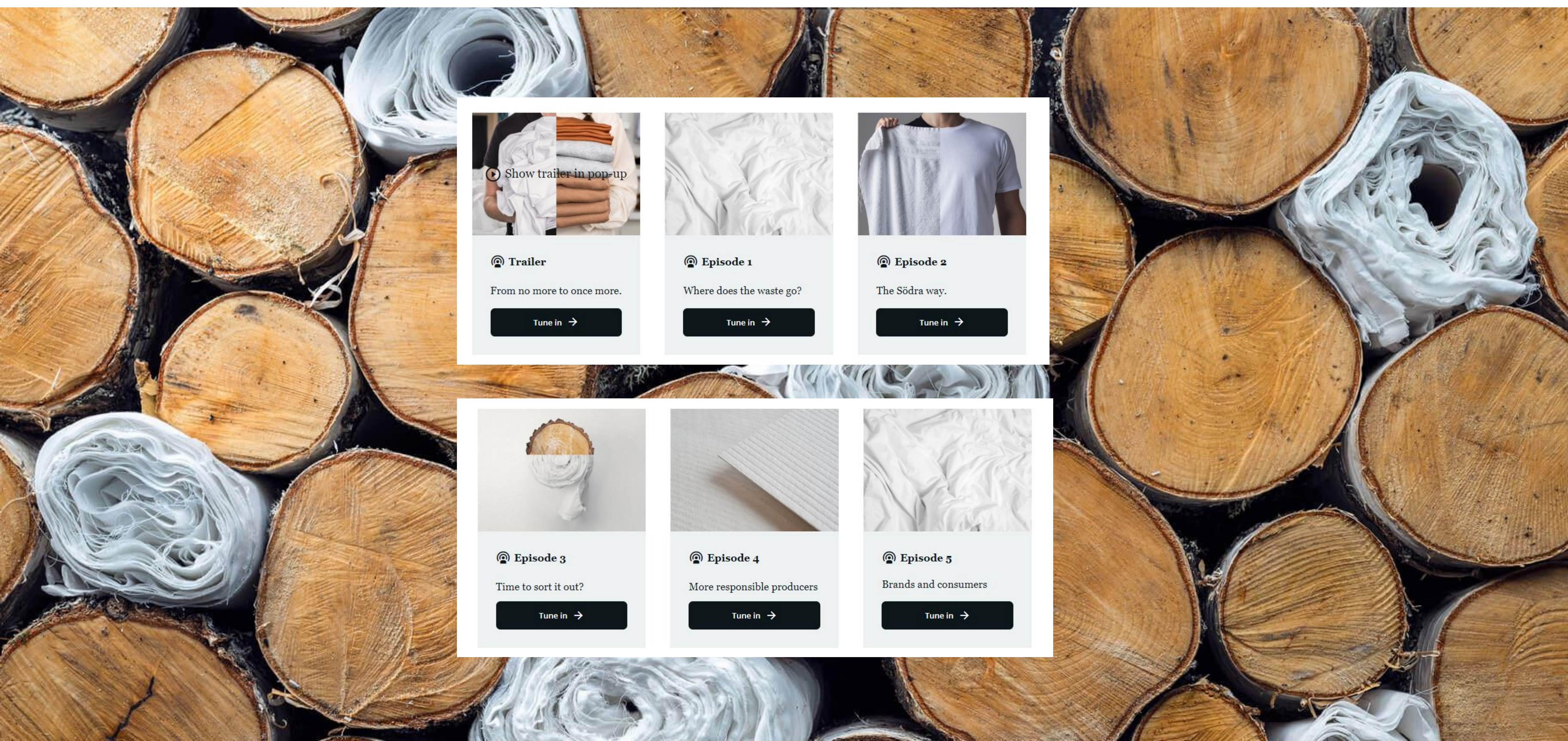



## The 2025 target
