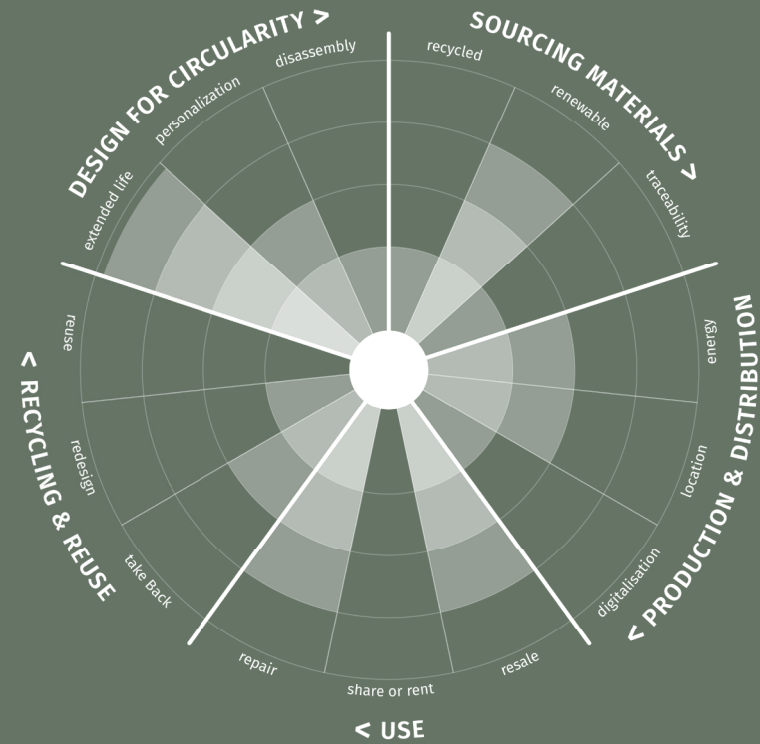

How they work on circular economy

Carl Hansen & Søn's collection of iconic furniture is crafted from materials that are precious natural resources. This commits the brand to use every piece and little scrap to its fullest, which has challenged the brand and triggered creative ideas for more sustainable production while passing on a legacy of craftsmanship.

Carl Hansen & Søn uses wood from sustainable forestry to produce the iconic CH24 chair designed by Hans J. Wegner in 1949. Residue wood is turned into valuable accessories. The sawdust that remains is turned into briquettes used to heat the factory and 400 local homes in the city of Gelsted.
