
How they work on circular economy

This is furniture built to last, which is precisely why the brand has entered into a partnership with Keepr Collective - to help provide design-conscious furniture with an ever-renewing lifespan.

Consider this: Emissions from the production, and shipping to Denmark, of a Nordic Eco-labeled J52B chair add up to approximately 31 kilograms of CO2 equivalent emissions. For reference, that's roughly equivalent to 91 large caffè lattes or three steaks of 300 grams each. So, every time a customer opts for a used chair rather than a brand-new one, that quantity of CO2 will not be released into our atmosphere.
