


How they work on circular economy

Relife Studio's mission is to reuse and recycle waste and surplus materials, mainly cardboard and twin-wall plastic - resources that are often seen as waste. Relife Studio takes these resources back into an additional production cycle and uses them for new products - without adding too many new resources and materials. All products can be repaired and, if necessary, separated into pure resources before entering another life cycle. Relife Studio's products consist of cylindrical interior designs, from vases and pen holders to lamps in different sizes. Their design is timeless and follows no fast fashion trends.
