SPOOR upcycles waste from the food industry. This means they upcycle something that would otherwise be regarded as waste and use it to create a durable material. Unlike many other materials, leather lasts for a long time, which means that the tanned hides today will still be around for decades. SPOOR offers hides with documented traceability. In practice, SPOOR does this by marking each hide with a unique number. This number tells the whole back story of the animal, which provides brands with information about animal welfare, responsible processing, LCA data from farm level and much more. Traceability enables to document a brand's sustainable actions and decisions in the value chain. Besides, SPOOR is working with Zeolite tanning providing leather without any heavy-metals or aldehyde. This creates biodegradable and compostable leather.
